

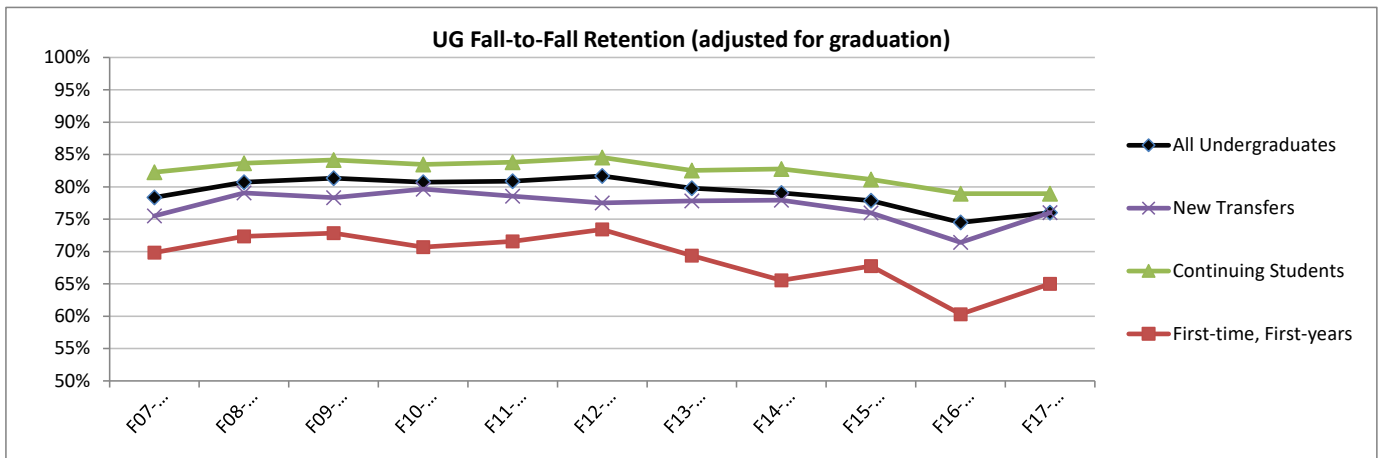
Summary: Fall-to-Fall Retention to Fall 2018

Undergraduate retention from Fall 2017 to Fall 2018 began to see some recovery from the declines last year for most categories of undergraduates. First-time-first-year retention improved 5 percentage points, and these gains were for both in-state and out-of-state students. New transfer student retention also rebounded to the rate of two years ago, and this was driven by stronger retention of Washington resident transfers. Continuing undergraduate students were retained at the same rate as the prior year.

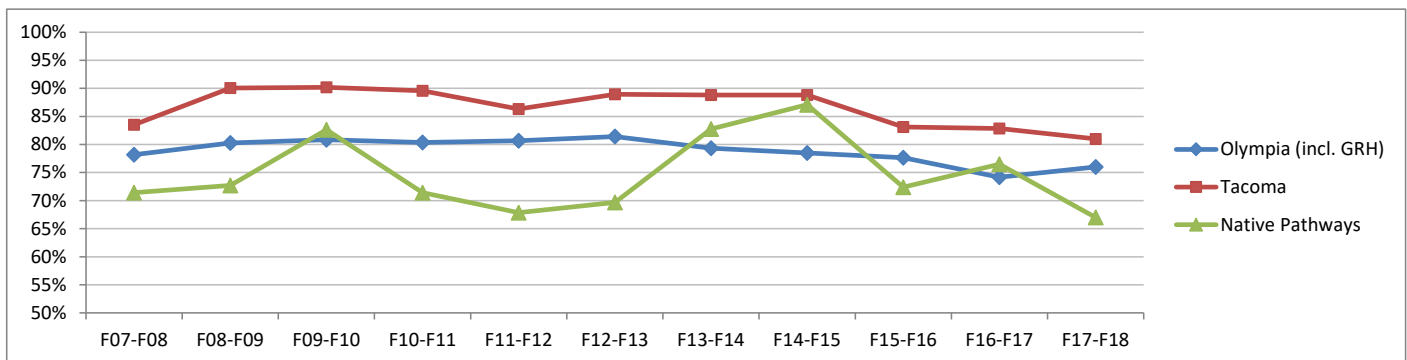

Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates for All Undergraduates by Location

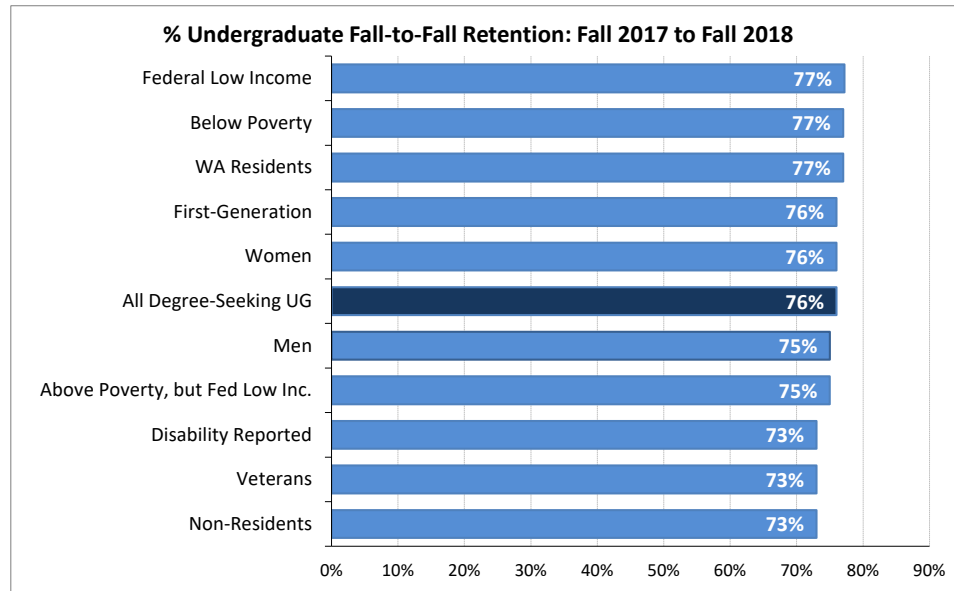

Olympia undergraduate retention improved, whereas both Tacoma and the Native Pathways program saw some decline in retention rates. Undergraduate Veterans, First-generation students, and those who report disabilities have slightly lower retention (73%) compared to the overall undergraduate rate of 76%. Notably, none of those subgroups of students had lower retention compared to the prior year, with disability remaining stable and improvement in retention of first-generation and veterans.

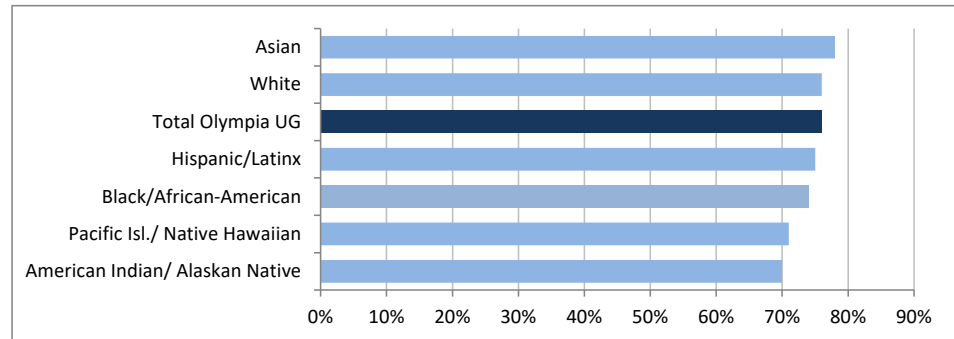
