Student Voice Survey Report #1

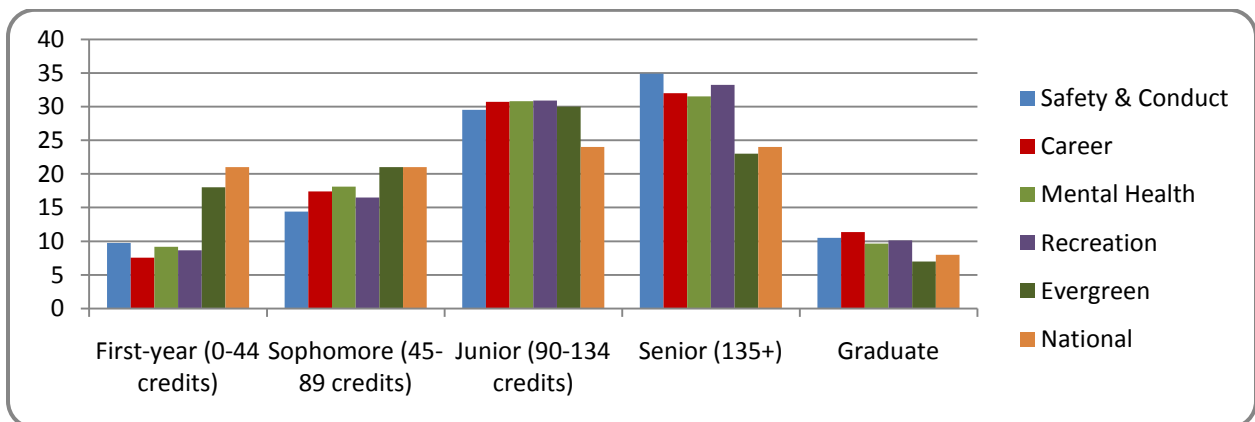


Student Affairs periodically conducts surveys about issues which impact students. In April 2010 Student Affairs conducted four surveys utilizing Student Voice, an entity which develops surveys in partnership with national experts. Every currently registered Evergreen student was randomly selected to participate in one of the four surveys, and upon completion of one survey was invited to participate in another survey. Total response rate across all surveys was 38%.

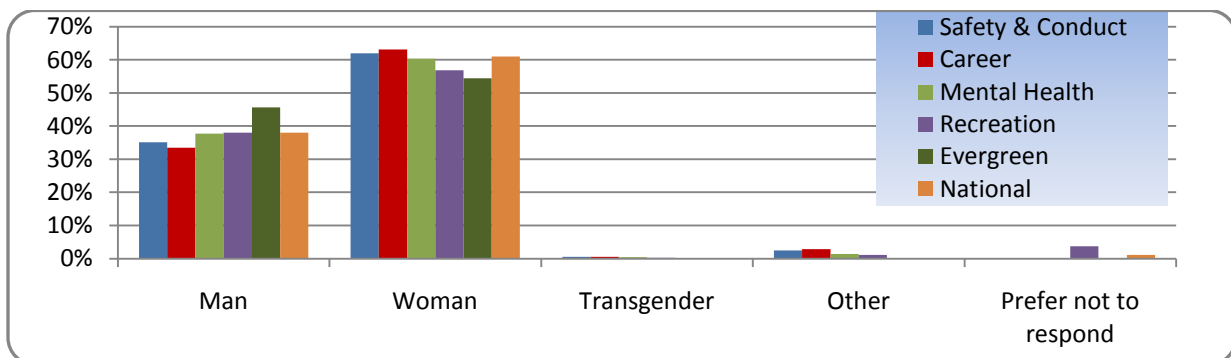
This report highlights some of the important **demographic results** from all four surveys (although not every survey asked the same set of questions). Participation was voluntary and all responses were completely confidential; the resulting data is reported only in the aggregate. Overall 95-99% of responding students were enrolled at the Olympia campus. National comparison data (when available) was similar across the surveys; however the national results from the Recreation survey had the largest number of respondents and is therefore used below except when otherwise noted.

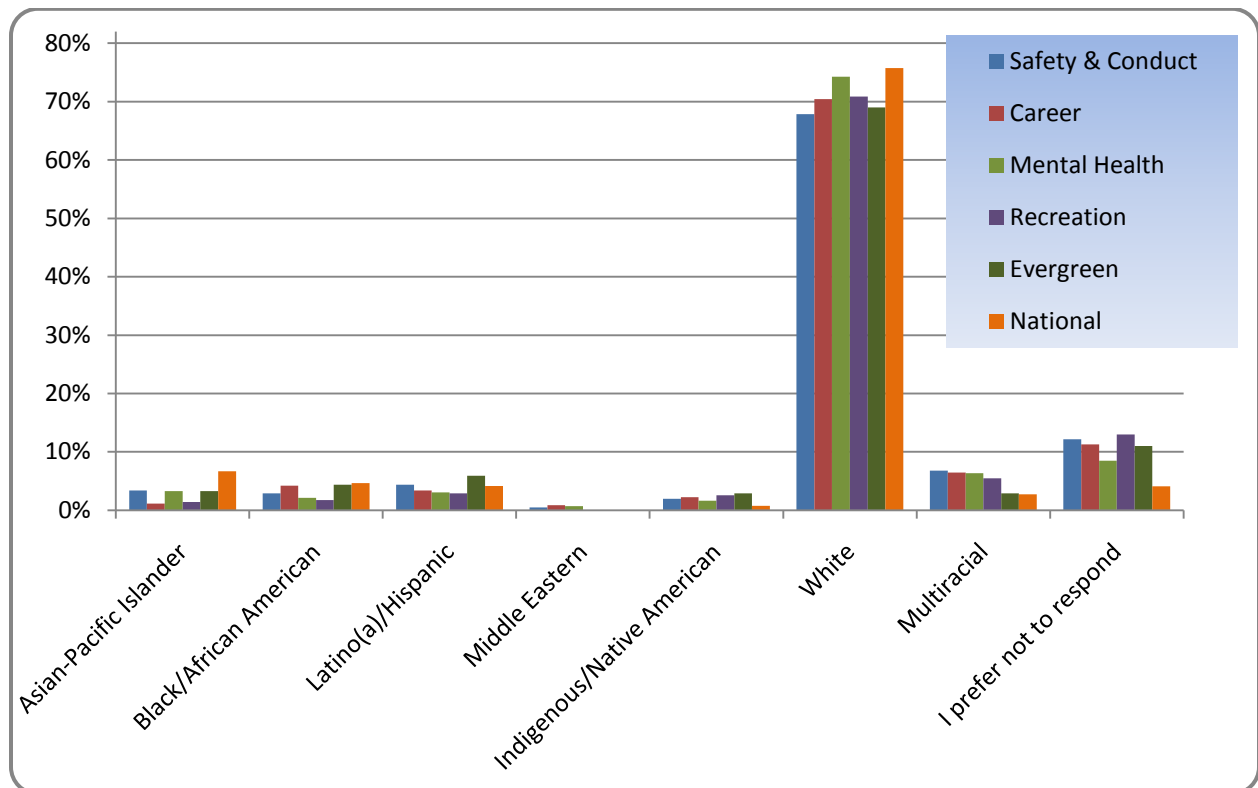


Gender

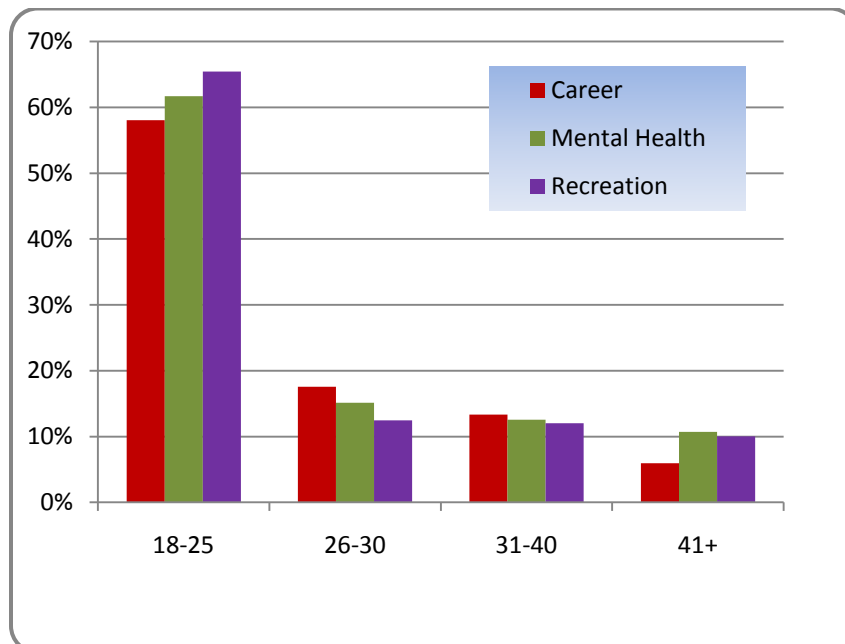

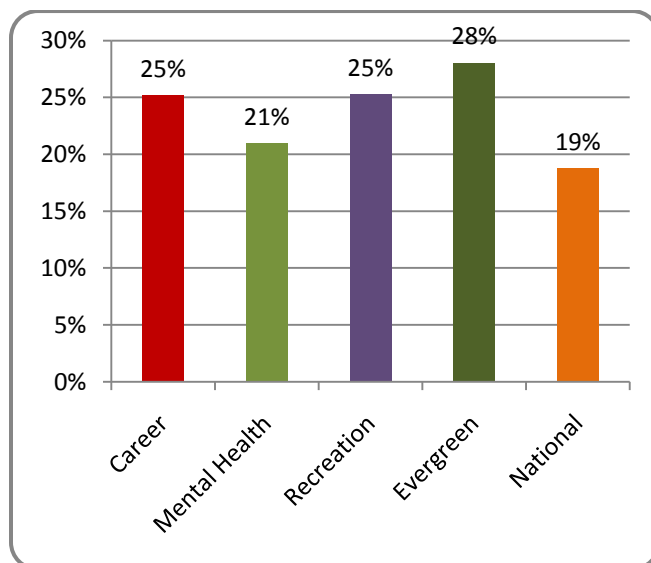

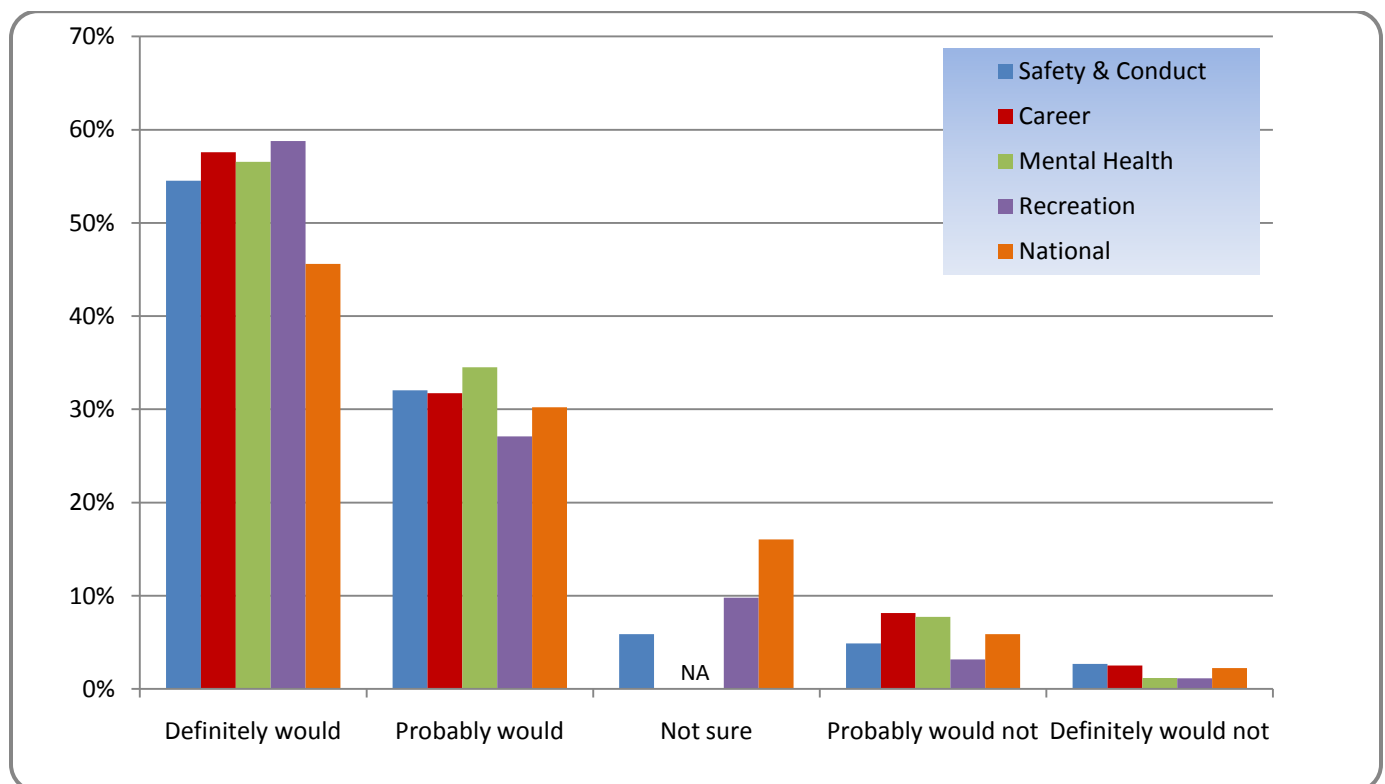

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First-generation Student

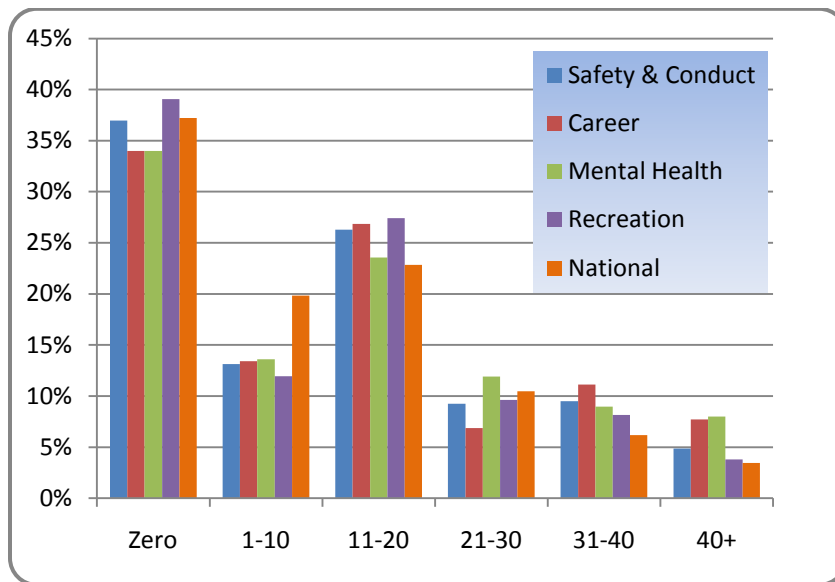


If you could start over again, would you still go to Evergreen?

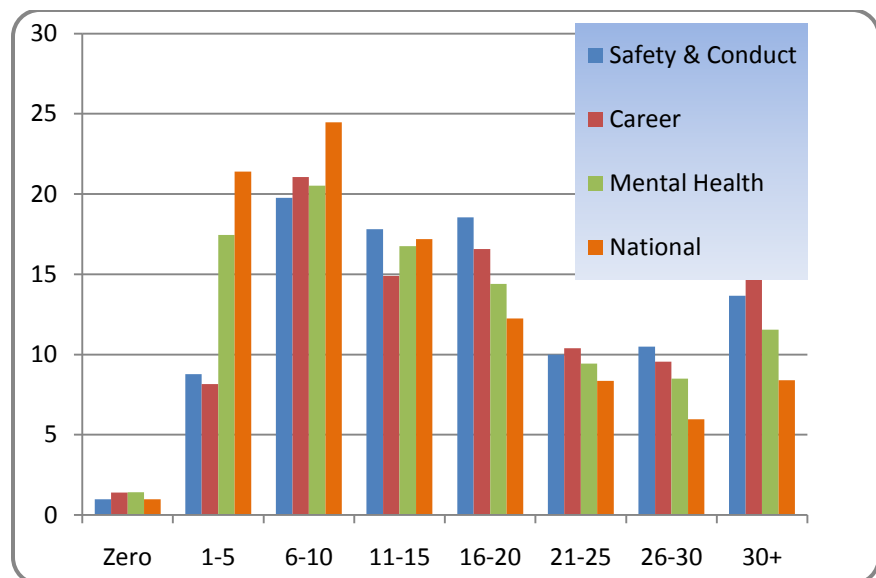


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Hours typically spent working for pay each week



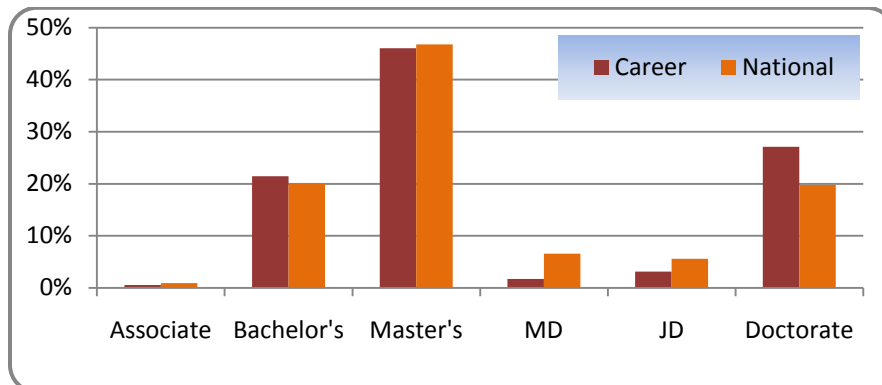
Hours typically spent a week studying



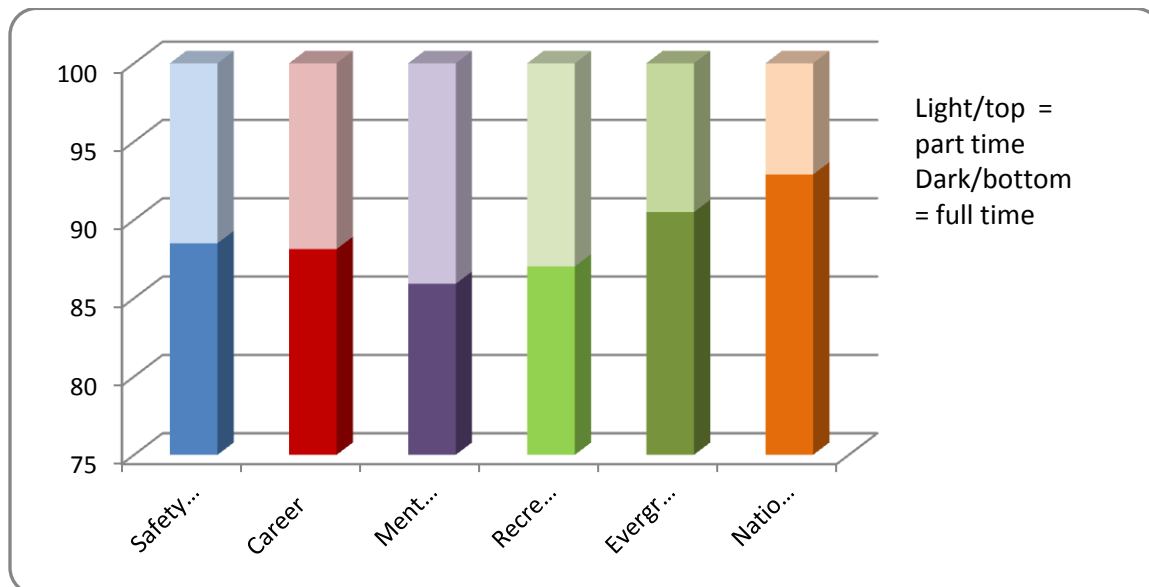

Highest degree planning to earn

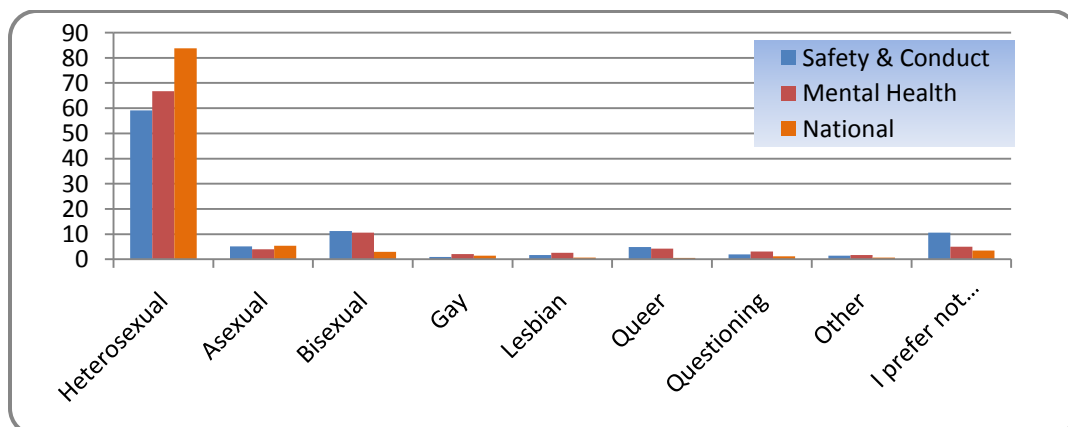

Enrollment Status



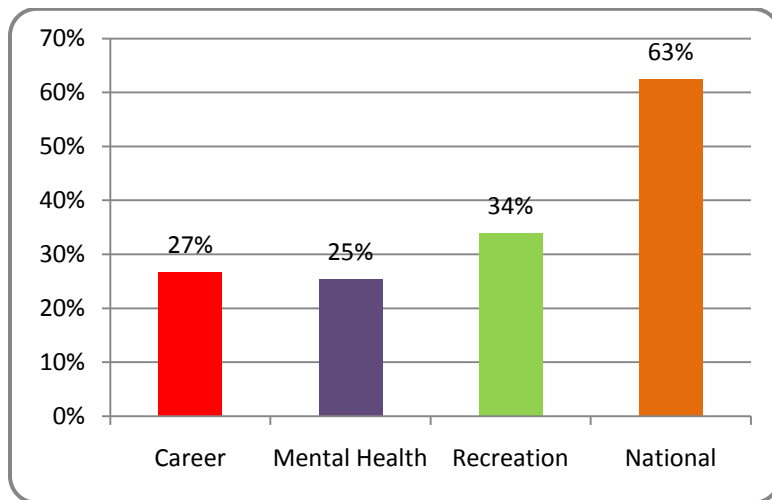
Sexual Identity



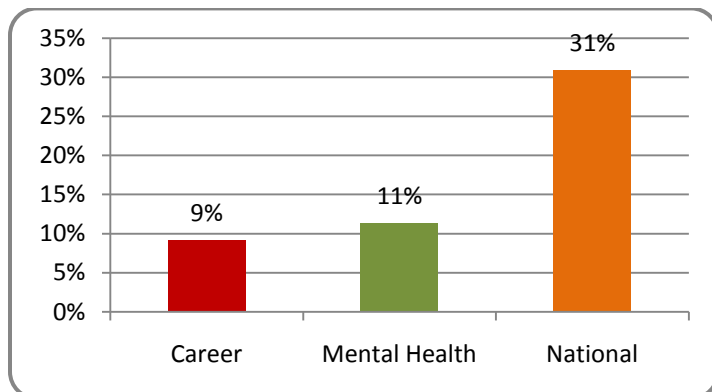

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Member of at least one student club or organization

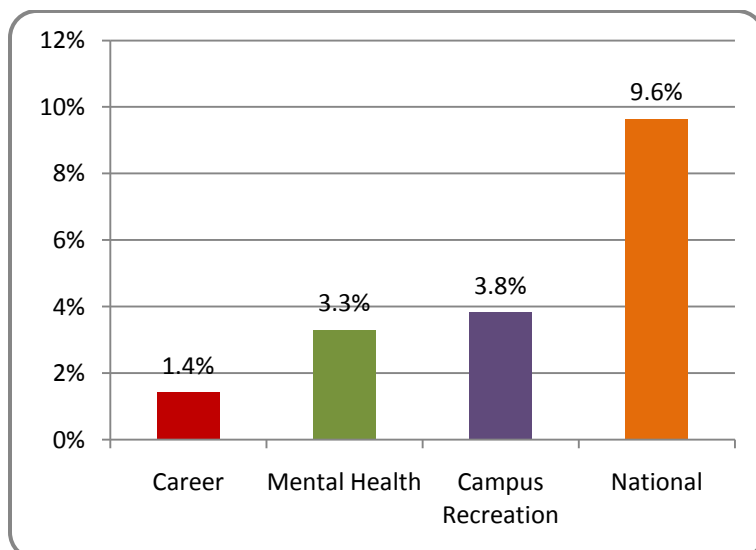


Involved in at least one intramural group, club sport, or organized fitness activity



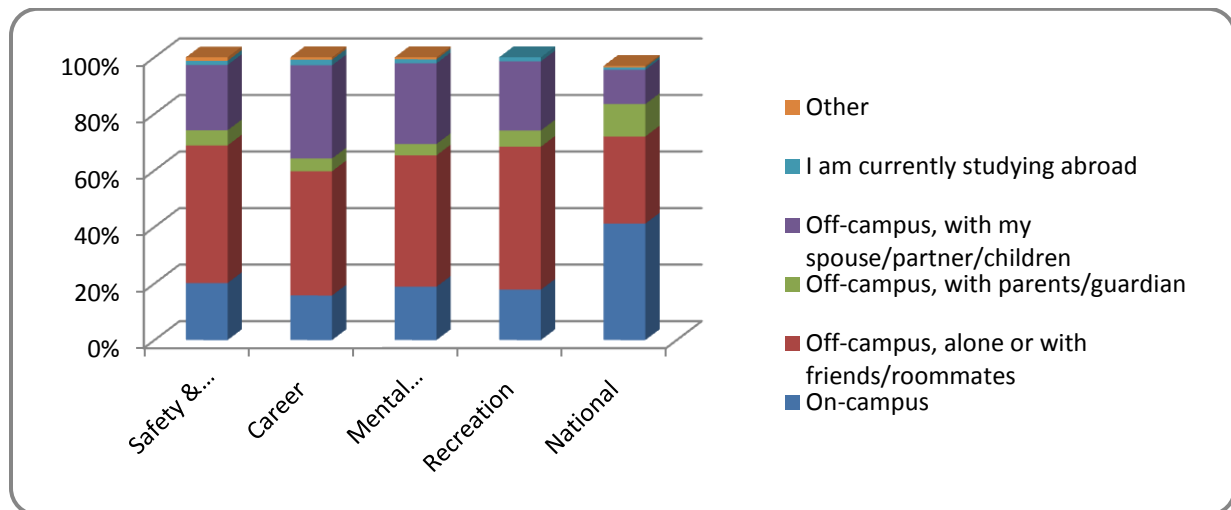

Member of an intercollegiate team

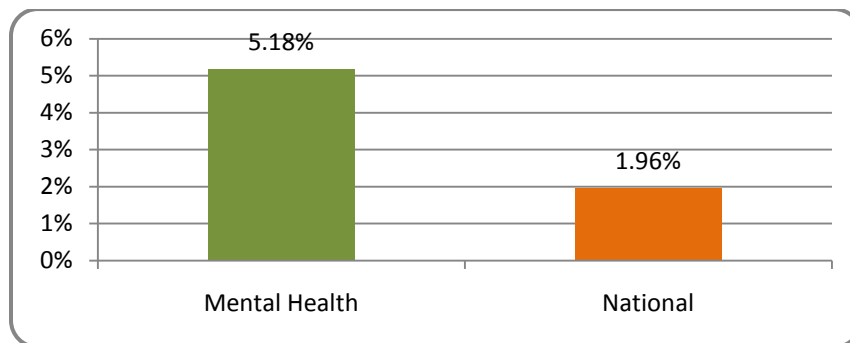


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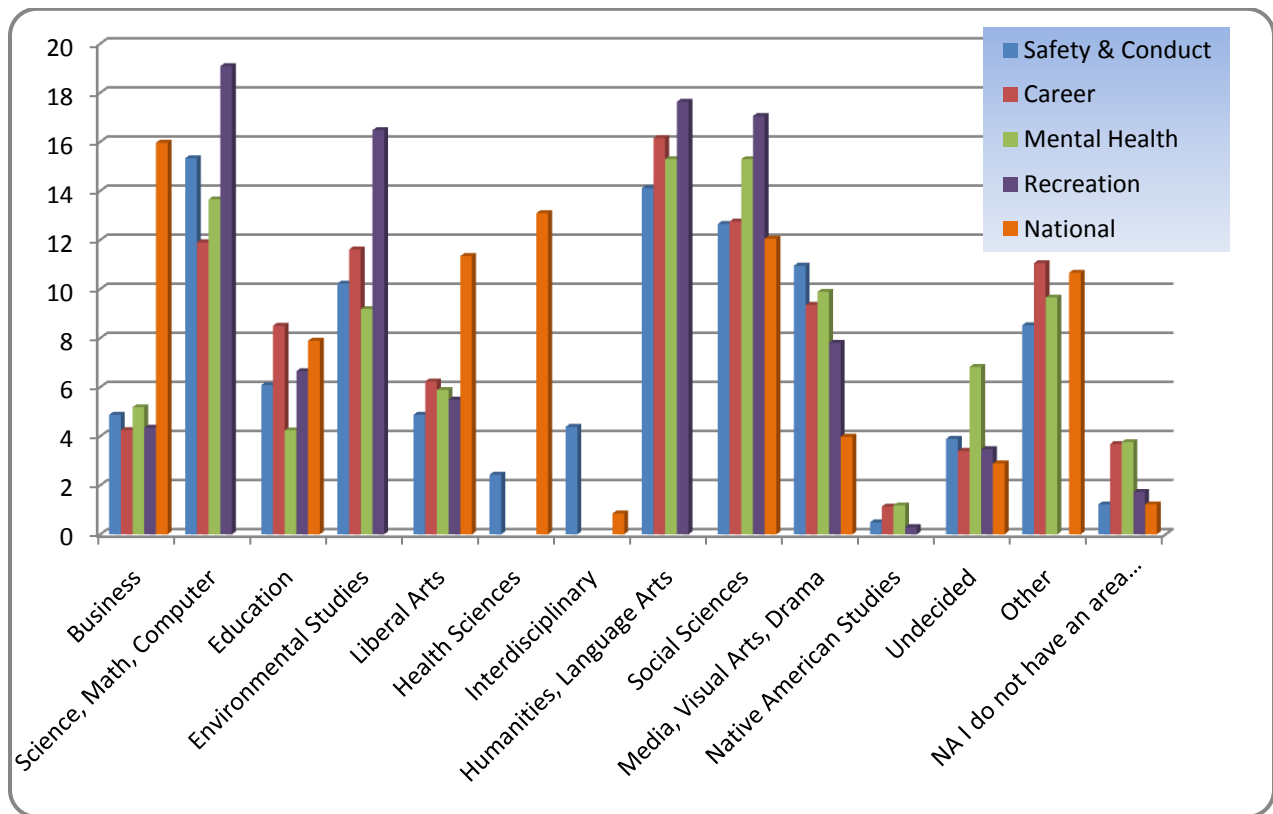
Living Situation



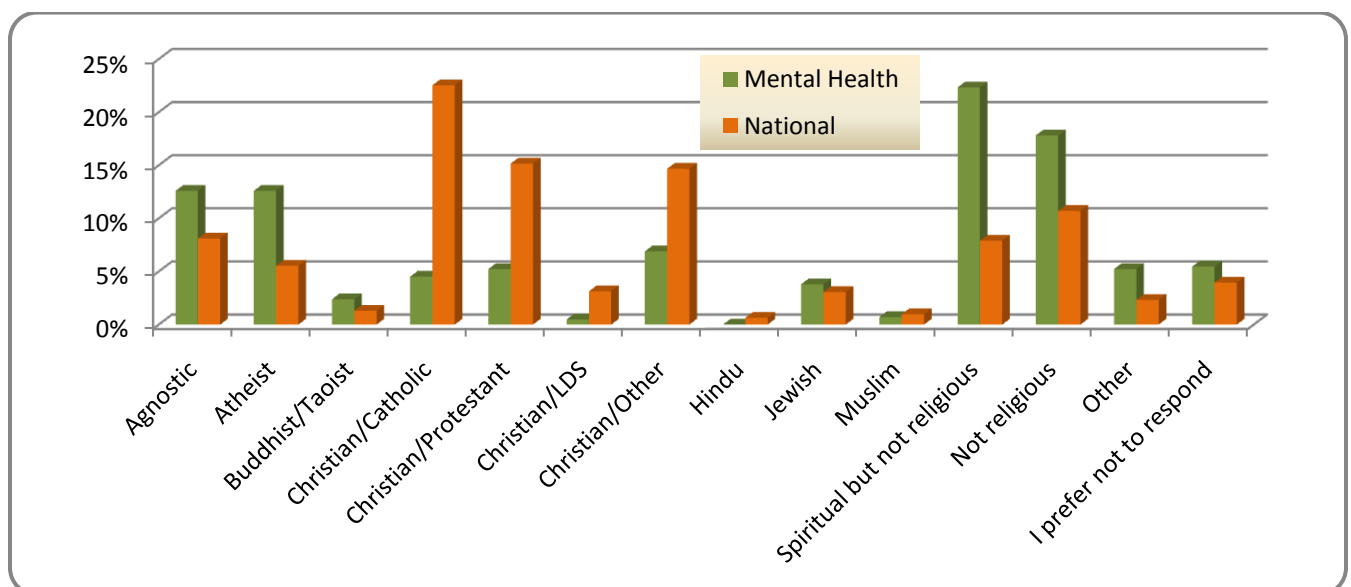
Military Service
