Admitted Applicants

Of the 824 transfer students who completed applications 93% were offered admission, only a 1 percentage point(p.p.) drop from the previous two years. *Transfer students include returning Greeners who have earned college credit from another institution since leaving Evergreen, but does not include returning Greeners with no new college credits earned since leaving Evergreen.*

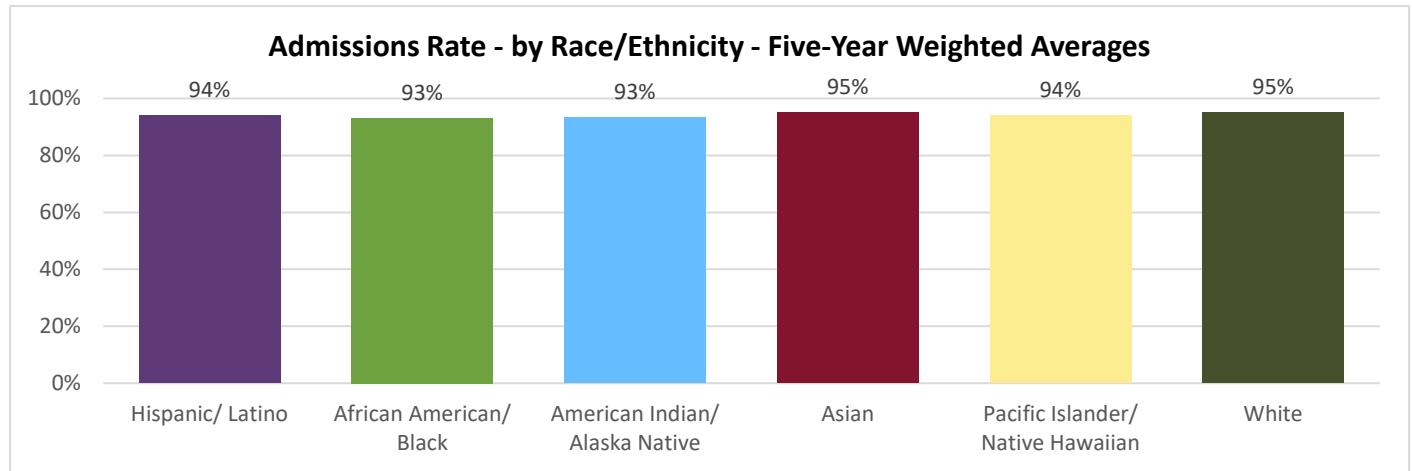
Five-year weighted averages of admission by race/ethnicity range from 93% to 95%. In 2018, African American/Black and American Indian/Alaska Native transfer applicants had the largest drops in admission from 2017 (10p.p. and 7p.p.). While these seem substantial, when comparing weighted averages the drop is less pronounced: for African American/Black transfer applicants, the five-year weighted average from 2014-2018 dropped 1p.p. from 2013-2017, and for American Indian/Alaska Native transfer applicants, the five-year weighted average from 2014-2018 dropped 2p.p. from 2013-2017.

In 2018, female transfer applicants were slightly more likely to receive admission, with a 4p.p. higher admission rate than male transfer applicants. Non-resident transfer applicants were slightly less likely to receive admission in 2018, dropping from 93%, in 2017, to 90%; admission rate for residents stayed the same at 94%.

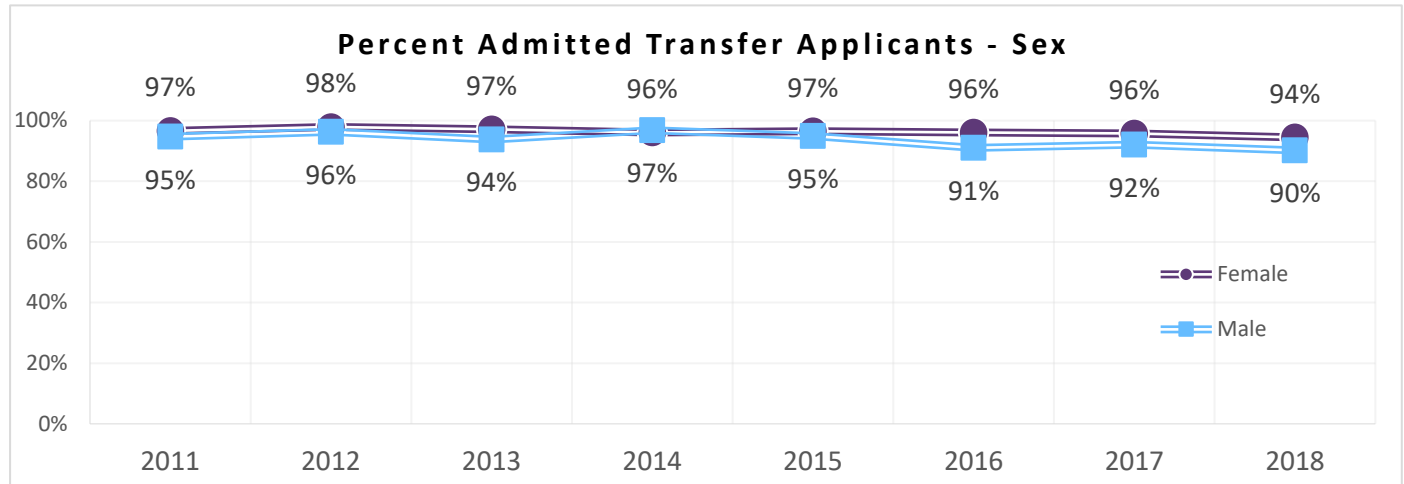

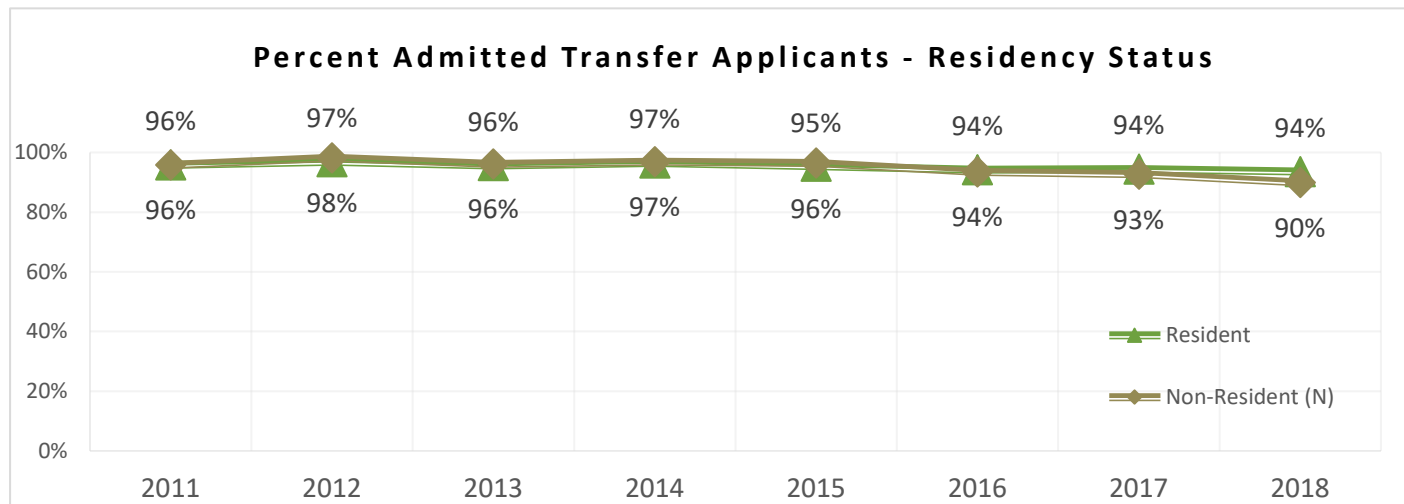

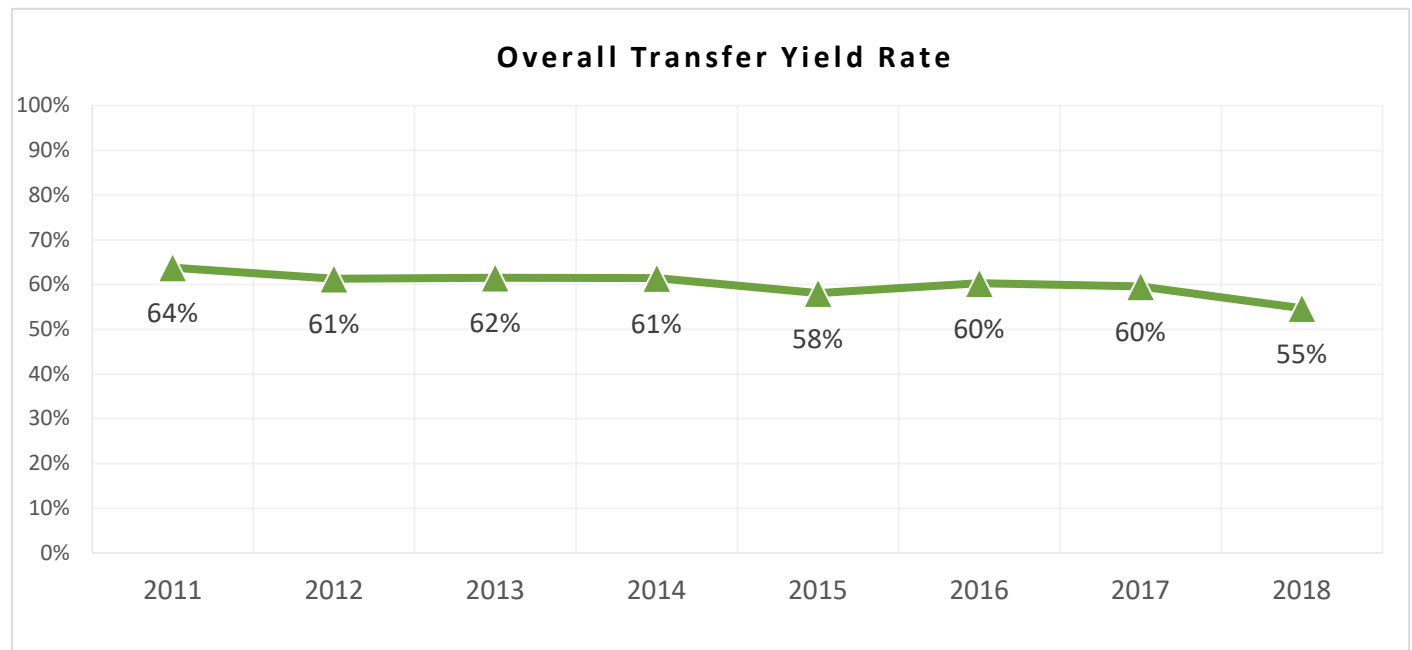
Yield Rates of Enrolled Degree-seeking Transfer Students

Yield Rate refers to percent of students who enroll after being offered admission

Of the 764 transfer student applicants who were offered admissions in 2018, 55% enrolled at Evergreen, a 5 percentage point(p.p.) drop from the previous two years. *Yield rate refers to percent of students who enroll after being offered admission.*

Five-year weighted averages of yield rates by race/ethnicity range from 56% to 68%; African American/Black and American Indian/Alaska Native admitted transfer applicants have been the most likely to enroll, both with a five-year weighted average yield rate of 68%. Asian admitted transfer applicants have been the least likely to enroll, with a five-year weighted average yield rate of 56%.

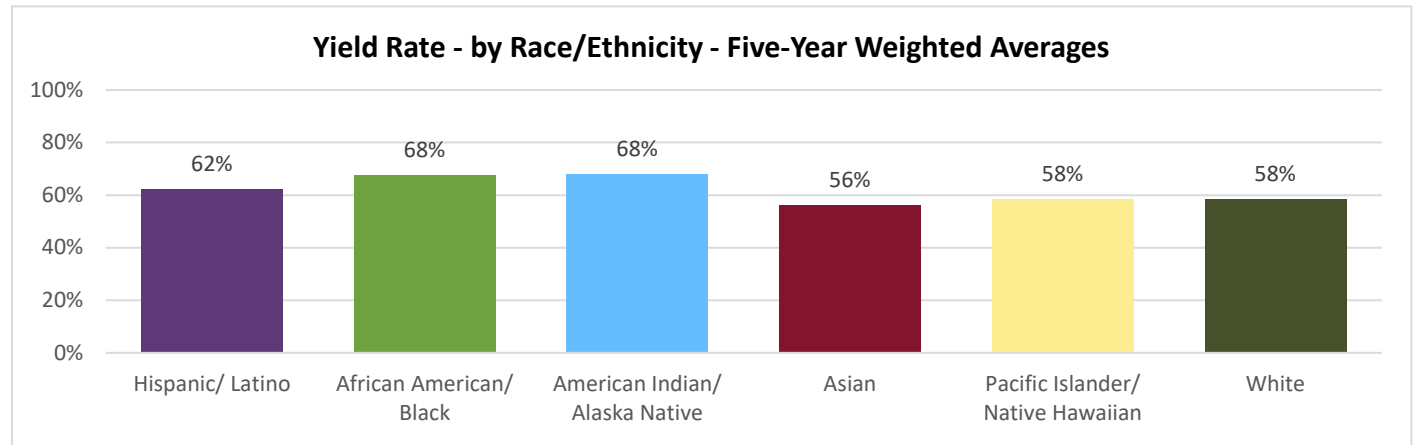
Admitted male applicants enrolled at a 9p.p. higher rate than females in 2018; yield rates for males remained consistent at 60%, while the yield rate for females dropped from 59% to 51% in 2018. Admitted resident applicants have consistently enrolled at higher rates than admitted non-resident applicants; in 2018 non-residents had a yield rate of 34%, a 3p.p. drop from 2017, while residents had a yield rate of 63%, a 5p.p. drop from 2017.

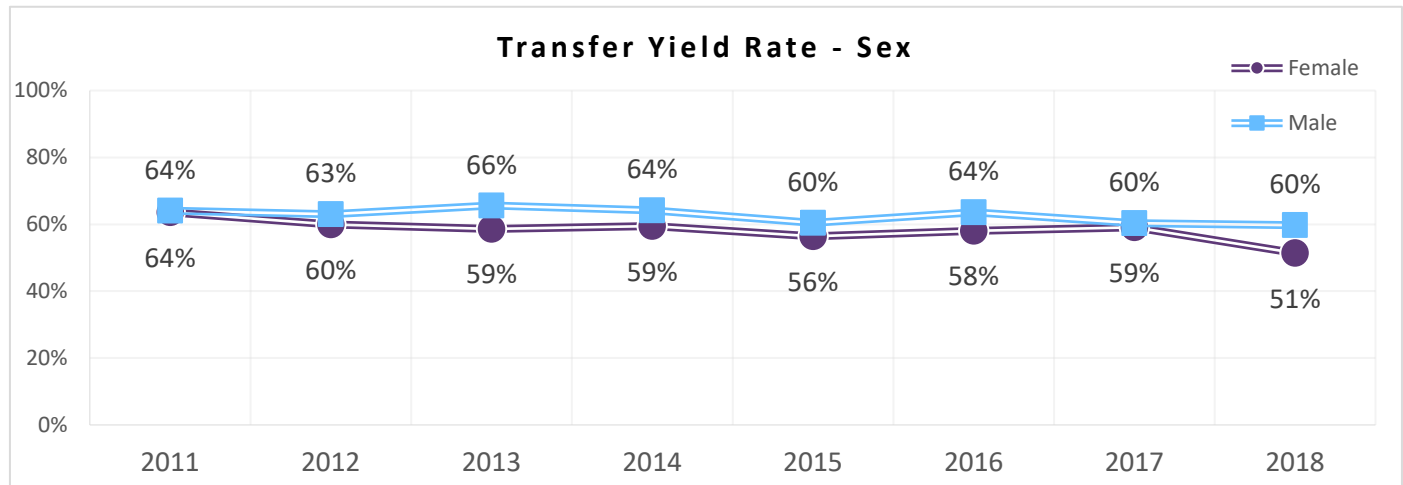

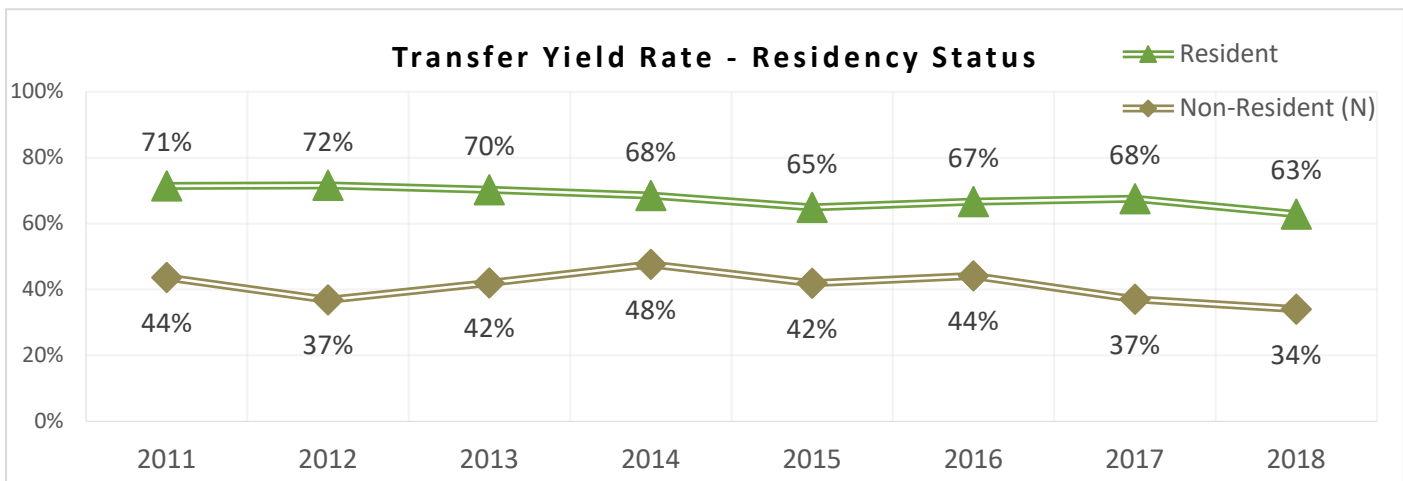
